DHS All-Hazards Unit Leader Courses Division Supervisor (L-960)

Provides the critical foundation for all Unit Leader positions in the Finance/Admin section, from cost accounting, personnel and equipment time recording, to documentation of claims.

Communications Unit Leader (L-969)

Provides the skills necessary for properly developing and managing a complex communications infrastructure during an incident or event. Includes interaction, involvement, and responsibilities in the planning process.
